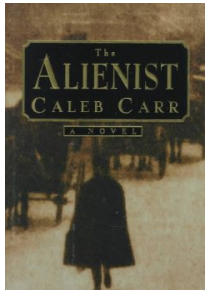


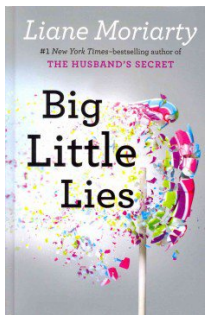

by Caleb Carr

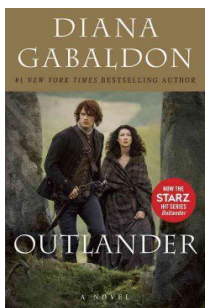

by Liane Moriarty

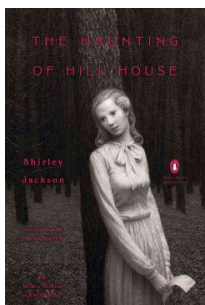

by Shirley Jackson

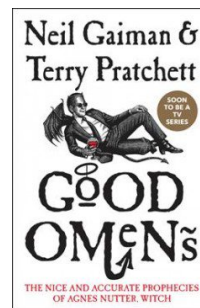

After the defeat of the Allies during World War II, the United States is divided up and ruled by the Axis powers.

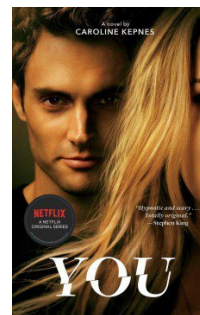

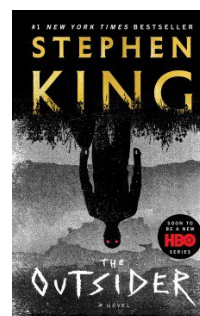
